Life of David: Pursuing God:

Fulfillment

Romans: 1:1-4

√ David possessed an experience more varied and instructive than all other Old Testament saints.

Paul, a servant of Christ Jesus, called to be an apostle and set apart for the gospel of God - the gospel He promised beforehand through His prophets in the Holy Scriptures regarding His Son, who as to His human nature was a descendant of David, and who through the Spirit of holiness was declared with power to be the Son of God by His resurrection from the dead: Jesus Christ our Lord. Romans 1:1-4 (NIV)

I. Prophecies concerning Messiah at first were veiled. (Gen. 3:15; Num. 24:17)

√ Many prophetic messages _____ near and far events. (Ps. 22:16; Is. 9:6)

√ David's throne would be established forever through his offspring. (2 Sam. 7:12)

√ The prophecies concerning Messiah became more and more refined. (Is. 9:1-7)

√ David's "seed" or offspring would be called **Jehovah Tsidkenu**:

"The _____ our _____." (Jer. 23:6)

II. God Himself would come as king and sit on David's throne

√ This was realized in _____ of _____. (Matt. 1:1; 27:11; Rev. 22:16)

√ The prophecies narrowed until they were fulfilled in Jesus Christ.

"Behold, you will conceive in your womb, and bear a son, and you shall name Him Jesus (*Y'shua*). He will be great, and will be called the Son of the Most High; and the Lord God will give to Him the throne of His father David." Luke 1:31-33 (NAS)

III. Fulfillment is where we end up when we follow the trail of David.

(Matt. 12:13; Mk.1:14-15; Acts 15:16)

√ The coming of the Son of God was the coming of the "Son of David."

√ There's "more to come" concerning God's promise to David. (Zech. 12:10)
